



Proper Application will give you RESULTS!

Do's

- 1.) Apply One Gallon of product to every 800-1,000 sq. ft. Heat Wave can be sprayed up to 48 hours before a Storm Event.
- 2.) Use Heat Wave on sidewalks, steps, ramps, Parking lots, etc...
- 3.) Use in cold weather conditions. Product is effective to -25F.
- 4.) Use a Downward stream nozzle or spray nozzle to apply.
- 5.) Do Pre-Wet any bulk or bagged salt with Heat Wave and reduce your salt usage by 30%.

Don'ts

- 1.) DO NOT MIX WITH WATER
Heat Wave is Ready to Use.
- 2.) Don't apply Heat Wave if there will be rain coming in before the storm hits. This will dilute out the effectiveness of product.
- 3.) Don't spray over the top of Accumulated snow greater than one inch.
- 4.) Do Not Apply when it is Windy.
Avoid Winds greater than 30 Mph.
- 5.) In long open stretches where Wind blows the use of Heat Wave is not recommended.

Remember Heat Wave is another TOOL to combat Winter.
